Trienále Ekoplagát č14 – medzinárodnú súťažnú prehliadku vydaných plagátov s tematikou ochrany prírody a životného prostredia pripravila Správa Národného parku Malá Fatra pod gestorstvom ministra životného prostredia Slovenskej republiky v spolupráci s Karpatskou iniciatívou pre mokrade a Považskou galériou umenia v Žiline

Výstava a katalóg sa realizovali vďaka finančnej podpore Ministerstva životného prostredia Slovenskej republiky, Nadačného fondu Kia Motors Slovakia v Nadácií Pontis a Karpatskej iniciatívy pre mokrade.

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MGR. DANA DORICOVÁ

Rezort životného prostredia v spolupráci s ďalšími inštitúciami pripravil už 13. ročník trienále EKOPLAGÁT. Podarilo sa to vďaka úsiliu pracovníkov Správy Národného parku Malá Fatra ako súčasti Štátnej ochrany prírody Slovenskej republiky a podpore viacerých organizácií a jednotlivcov, ako aj útvárov Ministerstva životného prostredia Slovenskej republiky. V aktuálnom ročníku ešte aktívnejším spôsobom prispel rezort zahraničných vecí, ktorý ocenil prínos EKOPLAGÁT k propagácii Slovenska v zahraničí.

Plagáty, ktoré prišli do aktuálneho trienále EKOPLAGÁT z 20 krajín dokázali, že za 36 rokov svojej existencie EKOPLAGÁT potvrdil svoje opodstatnenie, ale nabral aj nový dych. Plagáty sú nápadité a burcujú k zamysleniu sa nad súčasnými globálnymi problémami. Poukazujú na prepojenie ničenia prírody so zmenou klímy, znečisťovania životného prostredia so zdravím. Z mnohých plagátov je viditeľné, že stav životného prostredia je odrazom priorít spoločnosti a dôsledkom zamerania sa na konzumnú stránku alebo ľahostajnosti.

Úzke prepojenie ekonomiky a starostlivosti o životné prostredie je viditeľné nielen na plagátoch v tomto katalógu, ale aj v oficiálnych stratégiah, ktoré medzinárodné inštitúcie schválili. Európska komisia prijala v tomto smere viaceré dokumenty na rozpracovanie cieľov EU stratégie biodiverzity do roku 2020. Bola napríklad pripravená metodika na mapovanie ekosystémov a hodnotenie ich služieb a zrealizované viaceré štúdie, ktoré kvantifikujú náklady na zachovanie biodiverzity na jednej strane a „merajú“ prínosy pre spoločnosť na strane druhej.

Slovenská republika sa aktívne zapojila do procesu rozpracovanie európskych (a globálnych) cieľov biodiverzity. V roku 2014 vláda schválila Aktualizovanú národnú strategiu ochrany biodiverzity do roku 2020 a akčný plán na jej implementáciu, v ktorom má EKOPLAGÁT svoje miesto. Pripravila aj programové dokumenty pre financovanie biodiverzity z viacerých operačných programov na využitie eufondov v rokoch 2014-2020.

Podmienky sú teda pripravené, záleží len na nás, či ich v plnej miere využijeme. EKOPLAGÁT je príkladom toho, že úspech sa dostaví vďaka dobrej myšlienke, profesionalite a zanieteniu. Nech je pre nás inšpiráciou.

Resort of the environment along with other institutions has prepared already the 13th triennial of EKOPLAGÁT. It was possible thanks to the effort of the Malá Fatra National Park Administration, working within the State Nature Conservancy of the Slovak Republic and the support of other organizations and individuals, as well as the departments of the Ministry of Environment of the Slovak Republic. The Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of the Slovak Republic has been more actively involved this year and it appreciates the role of EKOPLAGÁT in promotion of Slovakia abroad.

Posters forming the collection of the EKOPLAGÁT 2014 came from 20 countries. Not only that it justifies the 36-years long existence of the exhibition but it also shows its fresh spirit. The posters are unique and provoke thoughts of today's global challenges. They point out the interconnection between nature devastation and climate change, environment pollution and health. Many of them show that status of the environment reflects the priorities of the society, focus on commercial life and carelessness.

Close connection between economy and environment protection is obvious not only from the posters in this catalogue, but also from official strategies approved by international institutions. The European Commission adopted several such documents aimed at implementation of the EU Biodiversity Strategy by 2020. To mention some, a methodology on ecosystem mapping and ecosystem services evaluation was developed and studies quantifying costs of biodiversity preservation and benefits it brings to the society were carried out.

Slovak Republic actively participates in the process of elaboration of European (and global) biodiversity goals. In 2014, the Government of the Slovak Republic approved the Updated National Strategy for Biodiversity Protection by 2020 as well as its Action Plan where EKOPLAGÁT has its place. Programming documents enabling to finance biodiversity in 2014-2020 from various EU funds have also been prepared.

The stage is ready; it is up to us to make most of it. EKOPLAGÁT proves that success comes thanks to a good idea, professionalism and enthusiasm. Let us be inspired by it.

Rok 2014 je rokom medzinárodnej súťažnej prehliadky Ekoplagát, konajúcej sa nepretržite od roku 1978. 13. ročník trienále, aj vďaka číslu 13, možno trochu symbolicky, ale hlavne tradične upozorňuje na problémy súvisiace so životným prostredím. Problémy, ktoré aj napriek tomu, že sú všeobecne známe, stále nie sú mocní tohto sveta ochotní plne akceptovať a začať zodpovedne, cez konštruktívny dialóg a prijatie účinných opatrení riešiť situáciu tak, aby sa špirala ekologických katastrof zastavila, alebo aspoň spomalila. Život sa vďaka technike neustále zrýchľuje a svet sa zmenšuje, ekologické problémy na iných svetadieloch sa stávajú aj problémami nás a našich domácností a nečinnosť nás stavia do polohy štatistov, stojacich pri pomaly odchádzajúcim vlaku, v ktorom sa vezú účinné opatrenia na zvrátenie tohto stavu.

Všetci intenzívne cítime, že si to už jednoducho nemôžeme dovoliť. Je preto našou povinnosťou nie len z pohľadu tradície, ale najmä aktuálnosti, odovzdávať odkaz autorov tejto myšlienky pracovníkov bývalého CHKO Malá Fatra Ing. Jána Pagáča a pracovníka Štátneho ústavu pamiatkovej starostlivosti a ochrany prírody v Prahe RNDr. Jána Čeřovského, ktorí chceli citlivou poukázať na problémy životného prostredia a vážnosť ich negatívnych dôsledkov na spoločnosť, ako aj na prehodnotenie hodnôt človeka – a práve toto je potreba stále aktuálnejšia.

Na záver mi dovoľte veriť, že sa nám to opäť podarilo. The international competitive exhibition EKOPLAGÁT is organised continuously every three years since 1978. This year it is already the 13th edition and it traditionally, and using the symbology of the numbers, it draws attention to problems related to the environment. Despite the fact that these problems are generally known, those who possess the power, do not want to accept this and responsibly lead a constructive dialogue and take effective measures which would stop or at least slow down the spiral of ecological disasters. Technology development leads to acceleration of life, the world is becoming smaller and ecological problems of other continents are becoming our problems. Inactivity makes us statisticians, standing on a railway platform watching the train of effective measures leaving.

We all intensively feel that we cannot afford this anymore. Due to respect for traditions as well as urgency of the topic, it is our duty to forward the message which the authors of this exhibition wanted to convey – to point out the problems of environment and seriousness of negative impacts they can have on society, as well as a need for human values' re-evaluation. And it is exactly the need for human values' re-evaluation that is more urgent still. These were the ideas of Ing. Ján Pagáč, former employee and head of Malá Fatra Protected Landscape Area and Dr. Ján Čeřovský of the State Institute of Monument and Nature Conservation in Prague.

To conclude, please accept my belief, that we were again successful in conveying this message. Let me wish you rich aesthetic experience, amplified by authors' talent to bring in and eternalize an emotion in a small piece of space and their ability to express the urgency of the problem as well as create an artwork pleasing to eyes and soul. Let's hope it will motivate each visitor to have an active approach to nature conservation. That is the point of it.

However, I would like to add few more words. I would like to thank everyone, who took part in organisation of the exhibition. It is their above – standard input that makes the triennial this exceptional. I would also like to thank the Ministry of Environment of the Slovak Republic for financial support, which is appreciated that much more in times of hardship. Thanks also belong to the Carpathian Wetland Initiative, which again supported the organisation team. And special thanks go to you, the visitors, without whom all this effort would be pointless. The exhibition waits.

Trienále Ekoplagát v roku 2014 otváramo s poradovým číslom trinásť. Aj keď sme ho pripravovali v takmer tých istých náročných podmienkach ako predchádzajúci ročník a napriek tomuto číslu, príprava skončila šťastlivo.

Opäť vďaka zanieteným pracovníkom hlavného usporiadateľa, ktorých by som najradšej všetkých vymenovala a nenahraditeľnej podpore gestorov, spoluorganizátorov, partnerov a sponzorov. Tých, ktorí už roky priam žijú s Ekoplagátom i tých, ktorí ho výrazne podporili tento rok po prvý raz.

V krátkom čase, ktorý nám znova zostal na organizovanie trienále, na výzvu reagovalo 50 autorov, autorských zoskupení a organizácií z 20 štátov krajín Európy, zemí od západu až po východ Ázie, zo Severnej i Latinskej Ameriky. Do súťaže poslali 104 takmer výlučne autorských plagátov zo svojej voľnej tvorby bez objednávok.

Kolekcia je neobyčajne vyrovnaná myšlienkami i výtvarnou kvalitou. Výberová porota neprijala len jedného autora a z jedného prihláseného súboru vylúčila jeden plagát.

Na výstave teda stretnete 49 autorov, autorských zoskupení a organizácií a 102 prác z rokov od predchádzajúceho trienále. Najväčšie kolekcie prišli z Poľska, Číny, USA, Kórei a Nemecka. Slovensko je zastúpené dvoma autormi. Najstarší účastník sa narodil v roku 1942, najmladší v roku 1993. Najširšie sú zastúpené generácie narodené v sedemdesiatych, osemdesiatych a šesťdesiatych rokoch.

V plagátoch dominujú, popri iných, najmä témy ohrozenia ovzdušia planéty, zamorovania vôd a života morí, rastúceho nebezpečenstva plastového odpadu. A samozrejme zodpovednosť človeka. Vo výtvarnom obreze emocionálneho, láskavého i otvoreného expresívne tvrdého postoja autorov. Vypovedajú ich veľmi často v nových a neočakávaných obrazových metaforách, ktoré nás o to viac prebúdzajú a upozorňujú .

Ekoplagát má 36 rokov. Tešíme sa z jeho veku a stôp, ktoré zanecháva. Veríme, že za podpory našich partnerov sa nám v budúcnosti znova a častejšie podarí vo výberových výstavách priniesť ich pôsobenie aj do iných krajín sveta. Rozširovať myšlienky a výzvy Ekoplagátu vo výtvarnom a obsahovom pôsobení plagátov významných predstaviteľov grafického dizajnu, ktorí sa jeho jednotlivých ročníkov zúčastňovali.

This year's triennial Ekoplagát is open with a sequence number 13. Even though it was prepared under almost the same demanding conditions as last time and against the symbology of the number, the preparation was successful.

And that is thanks to enthusiastic staff of the main organising organisation whom I would love to name, and thanks to irreplaceable support of the sponsors, co – organisers and partners, those who almost live with Ekoplagát for years and those who substantially supported it for the first time.

Fifty authors, groups of authors and organisations from twenty states of Europe, from west to east of Asia as well as from North and South America answered the call for submitting posters during the short time which was left for organising the triennial. They sent altogether 104 posters from their own artwork.

The collection is exceptionally balanced in thought and artistic quality. The selection committee excluded one author and one poster only.

That means we will meet 49 authors, groups of authors and organisations and 102 artworks. The largest collections were from Poland, China, USA, Korea and Germany. Slovakia is represented by two authors. The eldest participant was born in 1942, the youngest in 1993. The largest participation is by authors born in seventies, eighties and sixties.

Dominating topics of the posters are threat to the atmosphere, waters and sea life and growing danger of plastic waste. And a question of human responsibility, of course. All this is depicted with either emotional and mild or expressively hard approach of the authors. Thoughts are often pictured in new and unexpected metaphors, which are that much more awakening and warning.

Ekoplagát celebrates its 36th birthdays. We are pleased by the trace it leaves. We believe that with the support of the partners many other countries of the world will experience its influence and that we will be able to spread the thoughts and challenges of Ekoplagát.

14 ŠTATÚT TRIENÁLE EKOPLAGÁT

1. Ekoplagát je medzinárodná súťažná prehliadka vydaných plagátorov s tematikou ochrany prírody a životného prostredia. Koná sa raz za tri roky.
2. Poslaním a cieľom prehliadky je predstaviť, konfrontovať a podnecovať v medzinárodnom meradle plagátorov tvorbu, zameranú na ochranu prírody a životného prostredia, rozširovať poznanie a zvyšovať aktivitu spoločnosti pri riešení týchto úloh, napomáhať pri výchove k ekologickému myšleniu a etike. Trienále Ekoplagát bude zároveň podporovať ideový a umelecký rozvoj súčasnej užitej grafiky.
3. Názov prehliadky tvorí slovné označenie "Ekoplagát" s pripojením roku konania.
4. Miestom konania Ekoplagátu je mesto Žilina v Slovenskej republike.
5. Gestorom trienále je Ministerstvo životného prostredia Slovenskej republiky. Usporiadateľom trienále Ekoplagátu je Štátna ochrana prírody Slovenskej republiky – Správa Národného parku Malá Fatra vo Varíne. Usporiadateľ spolupracuje s umeleckymi, vládnymi i mimovládnymi, domácimi i zahraničnými environmentálnymi organizáciami.
6. Na prípravu Ekoplagátu usporiadateľia menujú komisárov a organizačný výbor na čele s predsedom, prípadne ďalšie pracovné komisie.
7. Ekoplagát môžu oboslať vydanými plagátkami autori alebo kolektívy autorov, ktorých vyzvali usporiadateľia prostredníctvom umeleckých, ochraňárskych vládnych i mimovládnych ekologickej organizácií alebo jednotlivci na základe zverejnenia v odborných masmédiách.
8. Plagáty zaslané na súťažnú prehliadku sa stávajú vlastníctvom usporiadateľa. Plagáty sa autorom nevračajú. Usporiadateľ zabezpečí ich dokumentáciu a archivovanie. Usporiadateľ si vyhradzuje právo použiť tieto plagáty na ďalšie podujatia, ich propagáciu v publikáciach a masmédiách bez nároku na honorár. Autori môžu svojím podpisom v prihláške súhlasiť s verejným rozširovaním originálneho plagátu alebo jeho rozmnoženiny predajom alebo inou formou prevodu vlastníckeho práva s tým, že výťažok z takého rozširovania diela bude použitý na účely ochrany prírody v Slovenskej republike podľa vlastného uváženia, najmä realizácie ďalších ročníkov trienále Ekoplagát a praktickú ochranu prírody.
9. Na súťažnej prehliadke sa udeľujú ceny v poradí: Hlavná cena, 1. cena, 2. cena, 3. cena. O ich udelení rozhoduje porota, ktorú vymenujú usporiadateľia. Porota má právo niektorú cenu neudeliť. Nositeľ hlavnej ceny má právo na ďalšom trienále sa predstaviť samostatnou kolekciou plagátorov.
10. Kritériom udeľovania cien je ideová a výtvarná úroveň hodnotených plagátorov.
11. Okrem súťažnej prehliadky môžu usporiadateľia organizovať sprievodné podujatia.
12. Podrobnejšie podmienky súťažnej prehliadky ustanoví súťažný poriadok, ktorý vydávajú usporiadateľia pre každý ročník Ekoplagát osobitne.

1. "Ekoplagát" is an international exhibition and contest of issued posters on the problems of the environment and nature conservation connected with a prize competition. It is held once in three years.
2. The main aim of the exhibition is to present, confront and stimulate the international production of posters concerning the environment and nature conservation. It should increase the activity of the public for solving the problems of ecology in the world of today. At the same time the triennial Ekoplagát will support intellectual and artistic development of the contemporary graphic art.
3. The title of the exhibition is "Eko-plagát" with joining of the year in which it is held.
4. The exhibition is held in Žilina – a town in the Slovak Republic.
5. The triennial is organized under the auspices of the Ministry of Environment of the Slovak Republic. The organizer of the exhibition Ekoplagát is the State Nature Conservation of the Slovak Republic – Malá Fatra National Park Administration in Varín. The organizer co-operates with artistic, government and other home and foreign environmental organizations.
6. To manage the exhibition, the organizers will appoint commissioners and the executive committee headed by its chairman or in some cases other commissions.
7. The authors and the teams of authors - who were addressed by the organizers of the triennial by means of the art, government and other ecological organizations or individuals through information in mass communication media - can send their issued posters to the exhibition.
8. The posters sent to the exhibition will become the ownership of the organiser and will not be returned to the authors. The organizers guarantee their archiving. They also reserve the right to use these posters for other exhibitions, to publish them in publications or other media without any claim for the author's compensation. The authors can agree to public distribution of the poster's original or its copies by sale or other means of ownership transfer, providing the income from the distribution will be used for the purposes of nature conservation in Slovakia according to SNC SR best knowledge, primarily for realisation of next EKOPLAGÁT event and practical nature conservation.
9. There will be the following prize-giving in the competition – Grand Prix, 1st Prize, 2nd Prize, and 3rd Prize. This awarding of the prize is carried by the Jury appointed by the organizers. The Jury has a right not to award the prize. The Grand Prix winner has right to present his/her own collection of posters in the next triennial.
10. The main criterion for awarding of the prize is an intellectual and artistic level of the posters.
11. The organizers can also organise accompanying events to the contest exhibition.
12. The full details of the contest exhibition will be given in the general rules of the competition, which are published by the organizers each year.
